<u>A Note : Eurasian Griffon Vulture (Juv) (Gyps fulvus)</u> <u>Scavenging</u> Carcass of Indian Wild Ass. (Equus hemionus <u>khur)</u>

I was invited in Wild Ass census organized by Gujarat state forest department . I was on allotted location Sami subzone. We were almost 15 Km Far from Koddha environmental centre. We spotted some movement and using 10*50 binocular we observed the movement and further was clicked the movement.

We made accuses and from 250 m distance. we observed a Eurasian Griffon Vulture (Gyps fulvus) scavenging on a dead Wild Ass (Equus hemionus khur) post development of the image identification was reconfirmed with various wild Enthusiasts & forest officers as well as cross verified from the field guide for the birds ID (Birds of the Indian subcontinent : India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka , Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh and the Maldives. Grimmett, Inskipp and Inskipp.)



This is the Note of Eurasian Griffon Vulture (Juv) (Gyps fulvus) scavenging on carcass on Indian Wild Ass (Equus hemionus khur) at around 15 km desert near Koddha environmental centre at Little Runn Of Kutch.

I was accompanied by local forest staff and note was observed date 21 Dec 2014. 2:07 pm ISD with Equipment Fuji Film Camera and observation Olumpus 10 * 50 binocular.
