

Finding your way around

Dungeness

Discovery trail





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1.7 miles | 1.5 hours

A picturesque loop showcasing all Dungeness has to offer - expanses of shingle, panoramic views across the lakes, bittern booming in the reedbed, and our Discovery area buzzing with life. Look out for our new bug hotel, and see if you can find any lizards along reptile runway!

To avoid disturbing the wildlife, no dogs (except assistance dogs) are allowed on these trails. Excluding public footpaths.

Boulderwall trail 2.2 miles | 1.5-2 hours



Extend your visit and include the Boulderwall fields - fantastic for spotting waders and egrets, and a favourite place for the glossy ibis.

Walkers Outland trail

3.1 miles | 2-2.5 hours

For those looking for a slightly longer, more off-piste route, immerse yourself in the vast shingle landscapes across Walkers Outland. Follow the footpath across the open shingle and see Burrowes Pit from the opposite side of the lake.

Water Tower trail

4 miles | 2.5-3 hours

This is our longest trail; encompassing the whole nature reserve, leading you across the road towards the Water Tower. Look out across ARC lake for a chance to see terns, waders and even the elusive bittern.
